RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Kingwood Mardi Gras Festival is organized by the Town Center Park Association (TCPA).
- TCPA does not supply free beads, throws or decorations to any parade participants.
- Vehicle drivers are prohibited from throwing objects from their vehicle due to safety concerns. All
 vehicles that will be having throws must have at least one passenger in addition to the driver.
- Each vehicle or float in the parade must be accompanied by a minimum of two walkers for each 8
 foot length of the entry who will assist with keeping the crowd out of the vehicle's path. These
 walkers must be provided by the participating group.
- A representative of the entry must attend a parade organizers meeting during the week prior to the event – details will be e-mailed.
- Event participation is not guaranteed until the committee has reviewed and approved the vendor. Approved parade applicants will be notified as soon as possible.
- The parade is a juried event, and TCPA reserves the right to decline vendors and/or products.
- Once accepted, an entrant is committed to the event
- The event does not have a rain date and will be held rain or shine.
- Applications will be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis. Parade participation will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- TCPA assumes no liability for damage, loss or theft.
- Electricity is not available. Please contact us if you plan to bring a generator. All generators must have a decibel rating of 70dB or less. Battery operated lights are acceptable.
- Parade participants are responsible for providing all necessary items to construct their parade display...
- Parade set-up will be between Noon —1:30 PM. Participants must be ready no later than 1:45 PM.
- Please supply us with a blurb about your participation, so it may be read during the parade, by the MC.
- TCPA reserves the right to modify event rules and regulations at any time.
- Any further details or instructions, or changes to these rules and regulations will be mailed or emailed to accepted participants.
