## **NEW** improvements introduced at the fall show

To make the Kingwood Cars Shows even better we have spent the months since the Spring Car Show creating new and exciting improvements. These improvements will enhance both participations, judging and spectator experience. Here's a short recap of the major changes we have made.

- To provide better conditions for judging we have significantly increased the number of classes to a total of 32 with 4 Best of Show awards as well. This allows us better opportunities to provide fair and equal judging to the entrants and their cars.
- At the Spring Show we successfully used new software which we have now fine-tuned to optimize efficiency during the show. It will automatically tally up judging data on the go, so the results are available as soon as the last car is judged.
- Judging will be performed by teams of two judges rather than one to allow for more detailed evaluations and observations.
- New judging guidelines and benchmarking have been established by the judges during pre-show meetings in the past months to create a more uniform base line for judging.
- Judges will be wearing shirts that identify them as judges. They will also enjoy improved communications tools during the show, which help ensure that all cars are judged.
- As work-in-progress over the next shows we will change the show site layout to a more spectator friendly format that will also greatly improve judging efficiency. In the future, cars will be staged by classes rather than individual locations. This will provide a better opportunity to compare cars in the same class in one location rather than being spread throughout the entire car show site. Please be patient and help us with this vital change.

Last, but not least, to avoid any confusion, it has been decided that while judges can still enter their own cars in the show for display, they will *not be eligible for any judging and/or awards.*
